IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION FOR STUDENTS

MANDATORY ATTENDANCE CRITERIA FOR MID-TERM EXAMINATIONS

It is MANDATORY for all students to attend a minimum of **75% of lectures, tutorials, and practical sessions** to be eligible for the upcoming Mid-Term Examinations, starting from **10th December 2024**. This requirement aligns strictly with the UGC guidelines and reflects the University's commitment to maintaining the highest academic standards and ensuring students get the best in academic delivery.

Non-compliance will result in strict consequences.

1. Debarred List:

Students failing to meet the 75% attendance requirement will be barred from appearing for the Mid-Term Examinations. The debarred list will be published on **4th December 2024 by 12:00 Noon**.

2. Admit Cards:

Admit cards will only be issued to students who meet the attendance requirement and have cleared the FEE dues. These will be available on 4th December 2024 by 5:00 PM.

3. Grievances:

STRICT POLICY FOR RE-MID TERM EXAMINATIONS

The University will allow students debarred from the December 2024 Mid-Term Examinations to appear in a **Re-Mid Term Examination (Re-MTE)** under the following ENFORCED condition:

• 100% Attendance Requirement:

Students MUST attend ALL classes without exception from **3rd January to 18th January 2025** to qualify for the Re-MTE.

Key Dates and Conditions:

1. Re-Mid Term Examination Schedule:

o Date: 20th January to 28th January 2025.

2. End Term Examination Eligibility:

 Only those fulfilling the 90% attendance requirement for the above period will be allowed to appear for the Re-MTE and the End Term Examination (ETE) starting in the 1st week of February 2025.

3. Non-compliance Consequences:

Students who fail to achieve 90% attendance from **3rd January to 18th January 2025** will be **PERMANENTLY BARRED** from both the Re-MTE and ETE.

This notification serves as a FINAL WARNING. All students are expected to adhere strictly to these attendance requirements. **No leniency** will be shown to those who fail to comply.

Take this policy seriously. Attendance is NOT optional. It is a critical component of your academic responsibility.
