Guidelines for the Practical ETE

The following guidelines are to be strictly adhered to by all students appearing for the practical examinations:

1. Preparation and Presentation:

- Each student is required to carry a hard bound Report of the TED Talk topic selected from the ETE Component shared earlier.
- Students will deliver their TED Talk in front of an Internal and External Panel.
- Talks must be well-structured, clear, and within the prescribed time limit.

2. Coordination and Communication:

- The Class Representative (CR) is responsible for coordinating with their respective section and the Internal Faculty Panel and ensuring all students are present and ready in their assigned slots.
- The CR must communicate with the examination coordinators to resolve any issues.

3. Evaluation Parameters:

- Content and Structure of the TED Talk
- Presentation Skills and Delivery
- Confidence and Engagement with the Audience
- Adherence to Time

For any clarifications, students are advised to contact their faculty or CR well in advance.

Guidelines for the Practical ETE for NOC Students

The following guidelines are designed to ensure a smooth process for NOC students:

- 1. Physical Presence (Preferred):
 - Students are strongly encouraged to attend the practical examination in person by taking leave from their employer.
 - Physical presence allows students to engage directly with the panel and showcase their skills effectively.
- 2. Alternative Submission Process (If Physical Presence is Not Possible):
 - In exceptional cases where attending physically is not possible, students must adhere to the following steps:
 - Submit a hard-bound copy of the report to the respective faculty before the examination date.
 - Email the video recording of the TED Talk to the concerned faculty, ensuring the video is clear, well-structured, and within the prescribed time.

 Attach a scanned copy of the No Objection Certificate (NOC) along with the video submission.

3. Mandatory Submission of Hard-Bound Report:

- The hard-bound report is a critical component of the practical examination.
- Students failing to submit the hard-bound report will receive a zero for that component, regardless of other submissions.

4. Video Submission Requirements:

- The TED Talk video must include the student presenting in formal attire.
- Ensure the video is free of background distractions and noise.
- Name the file as [StudentName_EnrollmentNumber_TEDTalk] for easy identification.

5. Evaluation Parameters:

- Content and Structure of the Report and TED Talk
- Presentation Skills (as assessed through the video or live delivery)
- Professionalism and Adherence to Guidelines

Note:

Failure to comply with the guidelines or incomplete submissions will negatively impact the evaluation.
