

NOTIFICATION

It has been observed that several students were unable to appear in the Mid-Term Examinations (MTE) for the Even Semester 2024-25, conducted from **28th April 2025 to 14th May 2025**, due to not meeting the requirement of minimum attendance criteria as prescribed by the University.

However, in the interest of student academic progression it was decided to conduct **Re-MTE Examinations** for the **debarred students only**, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. **Eligibility:** Re-MTE shall be conducted *only* for students who were **debarred** from the regular MTE due to shortage of attendance, are eligible
2. **Attendance Requirement:** Students must have a **minimum of 75% attendance** up to **22nd June 2025** to be eligible to appear in the **Re-MTE** as well as **End-Term Examinations** (ETE).
3. **Attendance Calculation:** Attendance shall be calculated from the **date of commencement of classes** for the Even Semester.
4. **Attendance Advisory:** All concerned students are strongly advised to maintain **100% attendance** till **22nd June 2025** to ensure compliance with the minimum attendance requirement.
5. **Date Sheet:** The date sheet for the Re-MTE Examinations will be uploaded by the **Controller of Examinations** on the University website in due course of time.
6. **Regular Updates:** Students are advised to **regularly visit the University website** for updates and announcements, in this regard.
